Who here knows who Larry Ellison is? Larry Ellison is a close friend of Donald Trump. Ellison is an AI and Data Center mogul. In addition to being one of the biggest backers of the recent AI gold rush, Ellison and his family own the rights to a staggering amount of media companies. Paramount, Skydance, Warner Brothers, CBS, CNN, HBO, Paramount, TikTok, Discovery, DC movies, BET, Food Network etc.

To say this man is influential is an understatement. Larry is also a proponent of total surveillance, and post privacy world. To quote " We're going to have supervision, supervised at all times, and if there's a problem AI will report it. Citizens will be on their best behavior, because we are constantly recording and reporting everything that's going on. Is this safety or control.

Alex Karp, CEO of Palantir also shares in his view. Karp also doesn't own a cellphone, use social media, and admittedly uses white noise machines to block laser microphones from picking up his conversations. Yet Palantir has its tendrils of access into DHS, Social Security, IRS, and most recently the Department of Agriculture. It's funny how when they want no more privacy, it never means for themselves.

Peter Thiel, the cofounder of Palantir and Paypal has also been in the news recently. Peter fled to Argentina before it became aware he was having secret meetings with some of the world's most influential from both sides of the aisle. Their agenda, navigating world war 3, battlefield technologies, and how to build a cult. Thiel himself is also known for saying he believes freedom and democracy cannot coexist, and is interested in building a post democracy world.

Thiel is also one of the earliest backers of Flock Safety, the ALPR company that changed the game when it came to ubiquitous warrantless surveillance.

But what am I talking about Flock for, TPD doesn't use Flock, well maybe their drones? I'm still not sure, we still need to do a public records request on that.

Lets instead talk about one of Thiels buddies instead. Jeffrey Epstein. Epstein along with former Prime Minister Ehud Barak were both financial investors of an Israeli Tech Company called Carbyne. Carbyne was known for its headways in predictive policing. They were leaders in hacking peoples cellphones with ease. Using their voice patterns, background noise, and movement patterns to mark individuals suspicious to law enforcement. Carbyne is used globally, in El Salvador propping up the Bukele regime, in Mexico used to fight the cartel. But most famously by the NYPD to track BLM demonstrators in 2020.

Carbyne I currently being bought out, and merging with another company. An Arizona company based out of Scottsdale. Its name is Axon, the same company that has a monopoly on AI enabled body cams used by both TPD and the Sherrif's department. The same company with ALPRS and FUSUS center used by TPD in its homeland security funded Community Safety and Response Center.

Theres a level of due diligence that is being greatly ignored by you all as leaders. Yet during the study session you mention about being responsible about technology, and you mention that I'm in attendance. You name drop me, yet none of you have had an actual conversation with me. Recently DEFLOCK TUCSON held a workshop with Cybersecurity experts from the UofA, ACLU Arizona, and someone familiar with Border surveillance. The workshop was recorded and e-mailed to all of you.
