Follow up on Jen Allen's last question about Flock cameras.

From what DeflockTucson is aware of Pima County does not currently use Flock Cameras, but it is still using ALPRS from Axon, Motorola, Verkada, etc. While Flock is the most notorious ALPR company, we are still vehemently against other ALPR brands as well. DeALPR Tucson just doesn't have the same ring to it.

I want to address the main defense we hear from pro Surveillance types.

There is no expectation of privacy in public area.

But this is not an expectation of privacy in public. This is not a simple static recording of a singular location which that defense would apply to. This is an interconnected panopticon, a dragnet that is constantly monitoring and updating on your movements. Where you live, where you work, where your kids go to school, where you shop, where you pray, and where you receive health services.

This is more akin to tracking, gang stalking

STALKING ars 13-2923

A person commits stalking if the person intentionally or knowingly engages in a course of conduct that is directed toward another person Suffer emotional distress or reasonably fear

A victims property will be damaged or destroyed

B The victim, family member, pet, or livestock is physically injured – In July 2024 in Toledo Texas a man named Brandon Upchurch had his plates falsely identified as stolen. During the stop police sicced a k9 unit on Toledo ripping out his hair and leaving bite injuries on his forearms.

JC and Carolyn Herron plus their 3-year-old granddaughter Penelope, Morristown, Tennessee (June 2025) Flock confused their "LOVEY" (letter O) plate with a recovered stolen truck's "LOVEY" (zero). Guns drawn. Grandparents handcuffed while their terrified granddaughter cried alone in the backseat. Cleared only after VIN check

A mother and her young children, Sherwood, Arkansas (February 2026) Flock misread their black Chevrolet Tahoe plate due to a loose/broken frame (X read as Y). Full felony stop with guns drawn. Parents handcuffed in front of the kids. Cleared only after investigation. Officer ordered to additional training. Read the local coverage: Arkansas Democrat-Gazette

1. "Course of conduct":

(a) Means directly or indirectly, in person or through one or more third persons or by any other means, to do any of the following:

(i) Maintain visual or physical proximity to a specific person or direct verbal, written or other threats, whether express or implied, to a specific person on two or more occasions over a period of time, however short.

(ii) Use any electronic, digital or global positioning system device to surveil a specific person or a specific person's internet or wireless activity continuously for twelve hours or more or on two or more occasions over a period of time, however short, without authorization.

Now I'm sure I've brought up that this is a clear

Arizona Constitution – Article 2, Section 8: Right to Privacy

Article 2, Section 8 of the Arizona Constitution states:

"No person shall be disturbed in his private affairs, or his home invaded, without authority of law."

13-3911. Definition of Warrant

A search warrant is an order in writing issued in the name of the state of Arizona, signed by a magistrate, directed to a peace officer, commanding him to search for personal property, persons or items described in section 13-3912.

13-3912. Grounds for issuance

A search warrant may be issued upon any of the following grounds:

1. When the property to be seized was stolen or embezzled – Not applicable, everyone is marked in passing.

2. When the property or things to be seized were used as a means of committing a public offense. – Not Applicable

3. When the property or things to be seized are in the possession of a person having the intent to use them as a means of committing a public offense or in possession of another

to whom he may have delivered it for the purpose of concealing it or preventing it being discovered. – Not applicable

4. When property or things to be seized consist of any item or constitute any evidence which tends to show that a particular public offense has been committed, or tends to show that a particular person has committed the public offense. Not applicable

5. When the property is to be searched and inspected by an appropriate official in the interest of the public health, safety or welfare as part of an inspection program authorized by law. Not applicable

6. When the person sought is the subject of an outstanding arrest warrant. Not applicable

This information can and is used by companies like Palantir who already were able to build confidence scores on immigrants, and AI algorithm that best determined if you were in a certain location or not. They are the testing grounds for future targets, trans? Dissidents? Political rivals? Minorities.

I know theres a lot of people here on the right who have issues with Sherriif Nano's tenure at the Sherrifs department. I find his main character flaw to coincide more with Laziness than ill intent. But I can agree I'm not comfortable with him or any others with this technology.

I shudder to think of what someone like Joe Arpiao could've done with tech like this. He was already faced with Gangstalking, racial profiling, intimidation, and other abuses. The wind changes, and you can never be sure who will hold the reins. But you can you can determine if they reins are of a Trained Horse, or an wild Elephant.

This tech is too underregulated, litigated, and proliferated to be met with anything but unease. I implore you all to protect your citizens who look to you for safety.
